

Pilot Certification ECB-UNRESTRICTED

 To ensure users are technically, functionally and operationally ready to join TIPS

- Central Banks and Instructing Parties will perform the tests and send the evidence to the Eurosystem who will verify the results
- A certificate will then be issued
- Pilot testers are asked to prioritise the certification tests and complete them within the defined certification testing period
