TARGET Services Registration form

Originally part of the workstream for T2

All Participants were able to register for T2 using the form in all Test environments and in PROD. During the design stage of the form, the MTRSG* Drafting Group made sure to allow the creation of party-service links to all of the TARGET Services and the creation of T2S and TIPS DCAs

Further enhancements

The form has now been enhanced with the ability to assign technical addresses related to T2S and TIPS as well as the addition of the DKK currency. It was sent to the T2-Working Group for a two week written procedure and all accepted changes will be inserted in JIRA and addressed. The final form would supersede the existing TIPS forms e.g. 8000 (these did not exist for DKK)

Ability to easily modify the registration form


The form was originally developed in Visual Basic


Now development is done by a dedicated ECB IT resource and the defects are logged in JIRA. This will be especially useful when Change Requests from the various services require changes to the form in the coming years

The TARGET Services Registration Guide


Once the current development work related to the TARGET Services Registration form is complete then a written procedure related to the accompanying the TARGET Services Registration Guide will be launched and a new version published

Registering in TIPS and adding a TIPS DCA






TIPS DCA Creation

Validations

The form allows for numerous validations e.g. BIC Length, DCA format. This means minimal back and forth between the participant and their National Service Desk (NSD). When used in conjunction with the TARGET Services Registration Guide, the registration can be carried out without error. The form will support the registration of the new TIPS Participants related to the upcoming measures

Creation of the Party and Accounts

The National Service Desk will create the party and accounts and then the participant checks the validity of the data and moves on to the tasks of user creation, message and report subscription.
